The grain direction of one panel doors will be vertical, and horizontal for two plus horizontal split panels.















# Special glass



Reeded

Tinted Grey

Its diffusing aesthetic makes obscure glass increasingly popular for sliding doors.

The glass and mirror is cut to size, toughened and safety backed before final assembly.









#### Good Practice

- Maintaining sliding doors will ensure their long-term durability.
- Spills of hot or cold liquid should be wiped away immediately with a dampened micro-fibre cloth.
- Cosmetics, moisturisers, oils, perfumes, varnishes and removers should be cleaned away immediately from any surfaces they touch to minimise surface damage.
- In rooms with fitted furniture, the temperature should be maintained to a reasonable level and the room should be ventilated. Wide swings in temperature, high humidity, and dampness may weaken the furniture's durability and longevity.

#### It is recommended to clean the doors once a month

- The frames, tracks, and MFC panels should be cleaned with a soft micro-fibre cloth dampened with atomiser water (99 parts water, 1 part washing up liquid), wiped, and then quickly dried with another soft micro-fibre cloth.
- Never use wet cloths or leave water sitting on the surface.
- Do not use coarse or abrasive cloths/sponges, white spirit, turpentine, solvent, glass cleaner, vinegar based, bleaches and other household cleaning products (abrasive or not) on MFC panels. These may irreparably harm the finished surface and will not be covered under any warranty given.
- Using a soft micro-fibre cloth, clean glass and mirror panels with regular household glass cleaner, ensuring that any overspray is wiped away immediately.
- In order to remove dust and small debris from running tracks, a vacuum attachment with soft bristles should be used.
